

List of Required Documentation

- Extract from the Register of Entrepreneurs and Non-Entrepreneurial (Non-Commercial) Legal Entities (in the case of a legal entity);
- Copy of an identity document (in the case of a legal entity - of the director/authorized representative; in the case of a natural person - of the land plot owner and the authorized representative);
- Certificate issued by the LEPL Scientific-Research Center of Agriculture confirming the suitability of the land plot's soil and its compliance with the requirements for all perennial crops specified in the application;
- Document certifying ownership of the land plot (extract from the Public Registry and cadastral map); in the case of a lease, the lease agreement shall be submitted together with the extract;
- Conclusion on the cultivation of the land plot and, where applicable, on water supply, issued by the relevant structural unit of the NNLE Rural Development Agency or by the Ministry of Agriculture of the Autonomous Republic of Achara; Contract and/or invoice submitted from the plant nursery:

In the case of purchasing seedlings from a local plant nursery, both an invoice and a contract shall be submitted. The contract must mandatorily include the following terms:

- Name of the plant nursery;
- Identification code, address, and contact information (telephone, email);
- Full name of the beneficiary (personal identification number); in the case of a company – its name and identification code;

- Name of the crop and variety;

- Characteristics of the seedling - height of the above-ground part of the seedling (not less than, cm); stem diameter at the root collar/graft union (not less than, cm); seedling form: A - bare-root, B - container-grown; seedling type.
- Unit price of the seedling in GEL;
- Total number of seedlings and total amount in GEL;
- Obligations of the plant nursery, specifying that the beneficiary shall receive seedlings of the agreed quality and quantity, free from any material and legal defects, in a proper and diligent manner, at the agreed time and place;
- Payment terms (The plant nursery shall ensure the full delivery of the number of seedlings specified in the invoice and contract once at least 30% of the total value of the seedlings specified in the invoice and contract has been credited/transferred by the beneficiary to the nursery's bank account.)

In the case of purchasing seedlings through import, an invoice/contract must be submitted in the Georgian language or accompanied by a notarized translation into Georgian. The document must mandatorily include the following terms:

- Name of the plant nursery;
 - Identification code, address, and contact information (telephone, email);
 - Full name of the beneficiary (personal identification number); in the case of a company - its name and identification code;
 - Seedling delivery timeframe;
 - Name of the crop and variety;
 - Characteristics of the seedling - height of the above-ground part (not less than, cm); stem diameter at the root collar/graft union (not less than, cm); seedling form: A - bare-root, B -container-grown; seedling type;
 - Unit price of the seedling, specifying the currency;
 - Total quantity of seedlings;
 - Information related to the plant label (plant passport), which must include:
 - category of propagation and reproductive material, variety name, rootstock name, year of production, batch number, form of reproductive material (seedling, cutting, bud, sapling, etc.), label number, and the name of the issuing authority.
- Invoices and/or contract for the irrigation system to be purchased (drip irrigation), in the Georgian language or accompanied by a notarized translation into Georgian;
 - Certificate issued by the LEPL Scientific-Research Center of Agriculture confirming the seedlings'/beneficiary's nursery's compliance with qualification requirements, in the case that the beneficiary plans to cultivate their own seedlings;
 - Bank details of the beneficiary;
 - Any other additional documentation as may be requested by the Agency.
